



District Two Permitting Requirements

Permit applications will need to be accompanied with the following information:

Utility Permit:

- Environmental Clearance
- GPS Latitude and Longitude (minutes and seconds format)
- Plan and Profile
- Nearest Mile Marker with footage
- Copy of contractor's liability insurance – Must have Dept. of Transportation as Additional insured
- MUTCD compliant traffic control plan
- Bore must be 36" from lowest point within right-of-way
- Utilities running parallel to roadway must include GPS and nearest mile post at both the BOP (Beginning of Project) and EOP (End of Project).
- 1 acre of disturbed soil must re-seed and submit NOi with EPA.

Access Permit:

- Site Plan
- Proof of Ownership
- Drainage plan and Drainage Report(if applicable)
- Traffic Information and Traffic Impact Analysis (if applicable)
- Median Opening Construction Plan w/Deceleration Lane & Acceleration Lane (if applicable)
- Environmental Clearance (if applicable)

Special Event Permit:

- Map of planned route
- Map of proposed detour (if applicable)
- Insurance certificate
- Contact information for Traffic Control (Name & Number)

Landscape Permit:

- Landscape plan
