We will have our winter book sale on Friday, February 10 from 9:30 am till 5:30 pm, and Saturday, February 11 from 10 am till 2 pm.

Librarian's Report – Valerie

- Children's program attendance for the month was 336, which was outstanding for 3 weeks.
- The Greater Artesia Foundation requested proposal of library items or projects to expend \$10,336.37.
 - 23 STEAM to GO kits for checkout by children
 - 7 iPads for new Sphero STEM Center robots with 7 Otterbox cases
 - 3 MacBook Pro Laptops for Study Rooms to replace 9-year-old laptops.
 - 15 Replacement seat pads for promenade chairs.
- We have been given permission by the City of Artesia to lower the educational requirements for Librarian positions which should help us get the library fully staffed.
- Omar Acosta has been promoted to Technical Services Librarian.
- Renewing our Erate Category I internet grant. PVT will help us with this and we will go from 40mb to 500mb internet at lower cost/month.
