# April 8th City Council Recap

## City Audit

There was a review of the city's financial audit for 2024. The third party who did the audit said that everything was in order and there were no findings. Thank you to our finance department for their work and success in managing our money.

## Dispatcher Appreciation

Mayor Henry signed a proclamation declaring April 13-19th as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week. The proclamation recognizes the vital work our local emergency dispatchers do in responding to 911 calls.

## Flag Football

The council voted to change 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade football from tackle to flag football. The recommendation came to the council after being approved unanimously both by the event board and the recreation advisory board. Reasons for changing to flag football included player safety as well as size discrepancies between players.

# April 22nd City Council Recap

## Plat Applications

The council approved a change to streamline the approval process for plat applications involving small amounts of public right of way. This change reduces the wait time for approval in these cases by many months.

## Police Barricades

The council approved the donation of vehicle barricades to the Artesia Police Department. The barricades will help ensure public safety at events where streets have to be blocked off. We want to thank the Greater Artesia Foundation for their donation of the equipment.

## City Limits

Our infrastructure department announced that city limits have expanded. This comes as two annexations were recently made official. The annexations of the Paris and York area and the North Richey area have both been approved and they are now officially part of Artesia. (See maps on next page)






