Artesia Animal Shelter

Armory Heights Subdivision

The Council approved the layout of the new armory heights subdivision. The new housing will consist of two-story condos on the north and south ends of the lot. The rest of the land will be used for single family houses. The construction of new housing is thanks in part to incentives recently passed by City Council.

Annual Leave Policy


City Council has approved a change to the city's annual leave policy for directors. The change gives directors four weeks of vacation upon hire. The council said that this will help hiring offers be more competitive when trying to bring on new directors.

Special City Council Meeting

Council has set a special meeting for December 15th to discuss putting the recently annexed areas of Paris & York and North Richey into voting districts. This will allow residents in those areas to vote and run in upcoming city elections. The public is invited to attend this meeting.

Amended Election Resolution

Council has amended our election resolution. Another seat from District 4 will now be voted on in our upcoming elections. This means one seat from Districts 1-3 and two seats from District 4 will be on the ballot in addition to the position of mayor.



Judging will be based on the Best Representation of the Christmas Spirit. A trophy and certificate will be presented to the winning tree and hold bragging rights until next year!


Pick Up

A message from our Utility Billing Supervisor

Water rates are recalculated each year in March. We use the consumption amounts for the months of November, December, and January to determine your rate.

To keep your base rate the same, the average usage needs to be 7,000 gallons or less if you live in the city, or 6,000 or less if you live outside of city limits. So, if you had higher usage in November, you still have a couple more months to bring that average down.

If you have a leak, please take pictures and contact us right away so we can let you know what you will need to provide in order to keep it from affecting your rate.
